RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

- 1. Adopt the attached Fiscal Year 2005-06 Personnel Resolution effective July 1, 2005; and,
- 2. Authorize the release of substitute positions for Fiscal Year 2005-06 as listed in the Fiscal Year 2005-06 Personnel Resolution.

SUMMARY:

The Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners establishes the Department's employment authority on an annual basis through the Personnel Resolution.

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2005-06 Personnel Resolution authorizes a total of 1,974 regular positions, 132 substitute positions, 105 special funded (grants and other funding sources) positions, and 19 in-lieu positions. It also authorizes 93 positions for which the Department received funding for this year (or "One-Time Funded Positions") and which are anticipated to be converted into regular positions in next fiscal year's budget (FY 2006-07). Finally, it authorizes 30 classifications (some at multiple paygrades or salary rates) that may be used to employees, and 23 classifications (some at multiple paygrades or salary rates) that may be used to retain hiring hall craft employees.

A comparison between positions authorized for FY 2004-05 and positions that will be authorized for FY 2005-06, upon adoption of the attached Personnel Resolution by the Board, is provided on the following page:
