SUMMARY:		

The AIMS system provides a means whereby budgeted revenue and expense information can be recorded at the individual facility level. The MRP system provides a means for recording all the non-budgeted fees and financial transactions, including receiving and disbursing for facilities that conduct many recreational programs and activities.

Both systems utilize the American Management Systems, Inc., Advantage 2.0 Financial software, which resides in the City's Enterprise Server. Using data provided by its users, these systems maintain a financial database creating reports in detail or summary level. These systems also generate monthly district summary reports and regional summary reports for management.

Expenditures will be posted to Fund 302, Appropriation Account 3040, Department 88, in fiscal year 2005-2006.
