

SUMMARY

The Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) is applying for state (Proposition 68) and Los Angeles County (Measure A) grants in order to fund a variety of capital improvement projects in its park system. Projects – such as LED lighting for sports fields and gymnasiums, upgrading electrical systems for HVAC, etc. – will require an Electrician Supervisor, Code 3865, to evaluate lighting and other electrical requirements, calculate estimates for electrical installations or alterations, and direct and monitor electrical work for the many projects anticipated to be funded by these grants. RAP management has, therefore, requested this position be established in special funded authority for up to three (3) years.

Should the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners approve this request, Human Resources Division staff will request the position be exempted from civil service pursuant to Charter § 1001(d)(4).

The top annual salary of an Electrician Supervisor is currently One Hundred Four Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$104,123.34).
